

PORTABLE FLUSHING KIT

CLEANING PROCEDURE

Prepare the seawater side of the heat exchanger:


- 1. Turn off and let cool the engine.
- 2. Begin isolating the system to be cleaned by disconnecting the hose from the seawater pump outlet.
- It is also possible to clean the strainer and water pump, be sure to close seacock valve before disconnecting hose and remove impeller prior to circulating.
- 4. Then disconnect the hose from the exhaust mixing elbow.
- Remove zinc anodes in the system and plug/cap holes. If replacing with new anodes, then do so after cleaning the system as RYDLYME Marine will slowly dissolve the zinc.

Set up circulating pump system:

- Connect one hose barb fitting to each of the supplied rubber hoses and hose clamp.
- 2. Connect one ¾" NPT threaded end of a hose to the submersible pump and place inside the 5 gallon bucket.
- Connect the other end of the hose's barb fitting to the disconnected hose of the seawater pump/seacock valve.
- 4. Connect the second hose to the disconnected mixing elbow hose.
- Finally, using the supplied clamp, secure the end of that hose to the 5 gallon bucket.
- The circulation loop should now be complete and mimic the below diagram.

Flush the heat exchanger:

- 1. Add one gallon of **RYDLYME Marine** to the bucket. This should submerge the pump inlet.
- 2. Add one gallon of water to the bucket to create a 1:1 solution.
- 3. This amount should be enough liquid to circulate through the loop without running the pump dry. If it is necessary to add more water, add the same amount of **RYDLYME Marine** to maintain a 1:1 solution.



Example Flushing Loop

- 4. Plug in the pump to turn it on.
- Check for any leaks or loose connections in the loop. Immediately unplug the pump if a problem is detected.
- 6. Allow solution to circulate for 2-4 hours depending on the amount of scale that has accumulated in the loop.

Rinse and disassemble:

- 1. Turn off pump and dispose of solution down sanitary drain/sewer.
- 2. Refill bucket with 2 gallons of clean water and reconnect return hose with clamp.
- 3. Turn pump on to rinse for 5 minutes.
- Upon completion, discard rinse water and begin disassembly of flushing kit.
- 5. Reconnect hoses to seawater pump outlet and to exhaust mixing elbow.
- 6. Check that hoses are secure and return to service.
- Alternatively, reconnecting OEM hoses and starting the engine to flush with seawater is acceptable.

Just spray it on, let it penetrate the deposit for 20-30 seconds and rinse off and/or wipe clean with a damp cloth. For larger or tougher jobs that may require brushes, pressure washer or other equipment, please contact the manufacturer for dilution and cleaning recommendations. Please shake bottle
